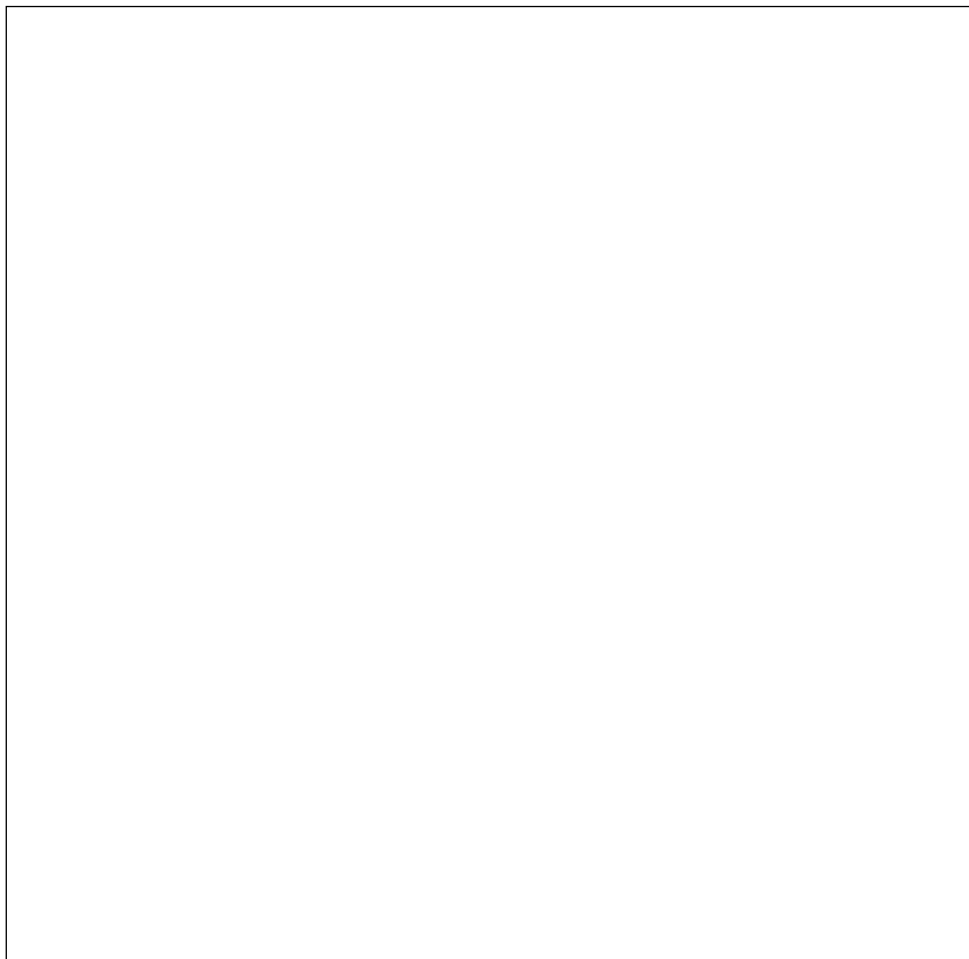

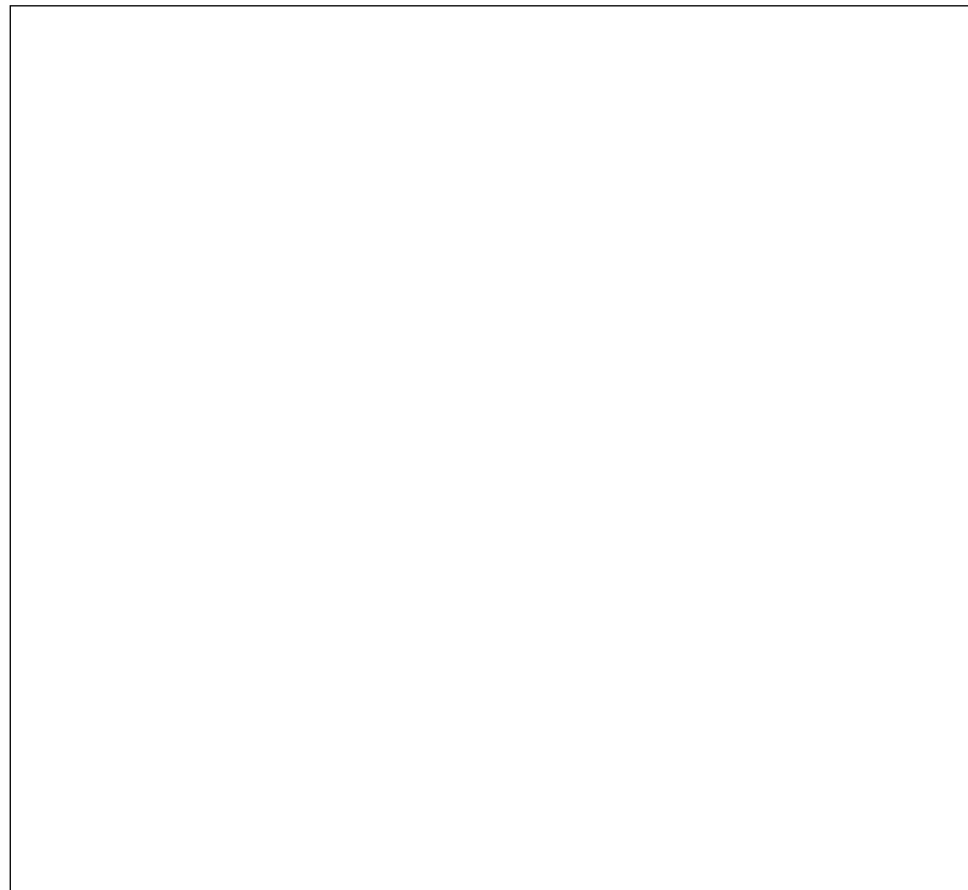
Once upon a time there was a little girl called Goldilocks.

“Someone’s been sleeping in our beds”, said Daddy Bear.

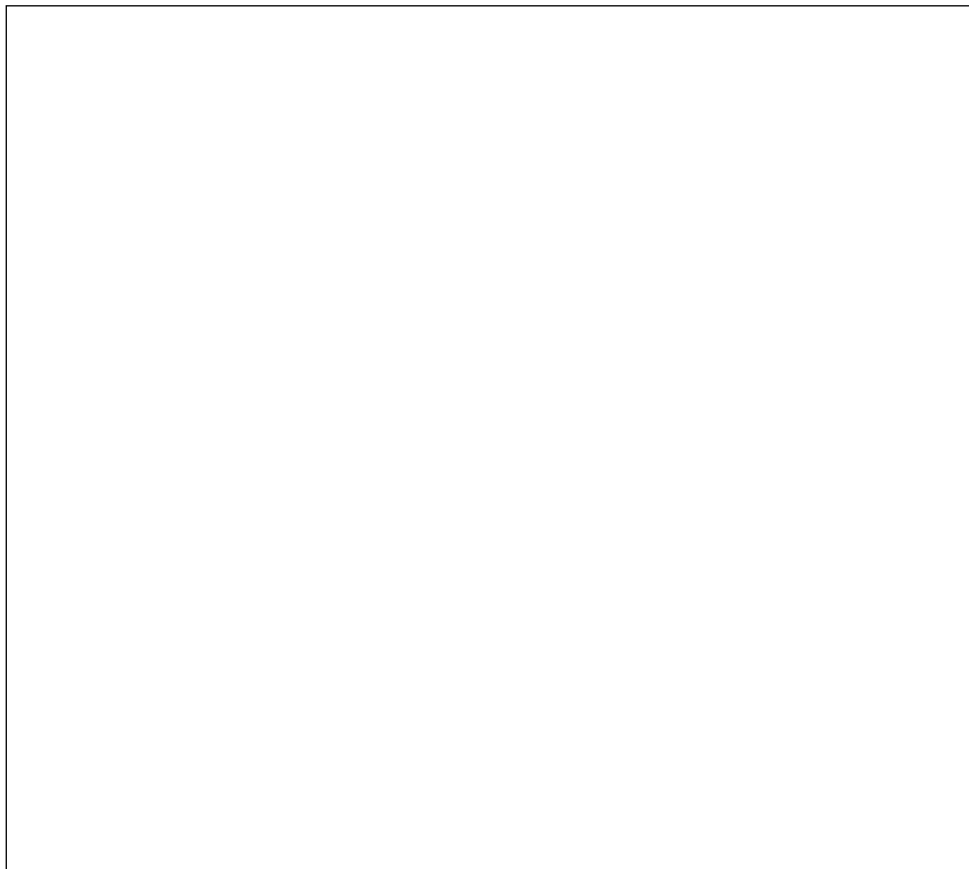
“And they’re still there!” said Baby Bear.

As Goldilocks was sleeping, the three bears arrived home. They looked at the bowls on the table.

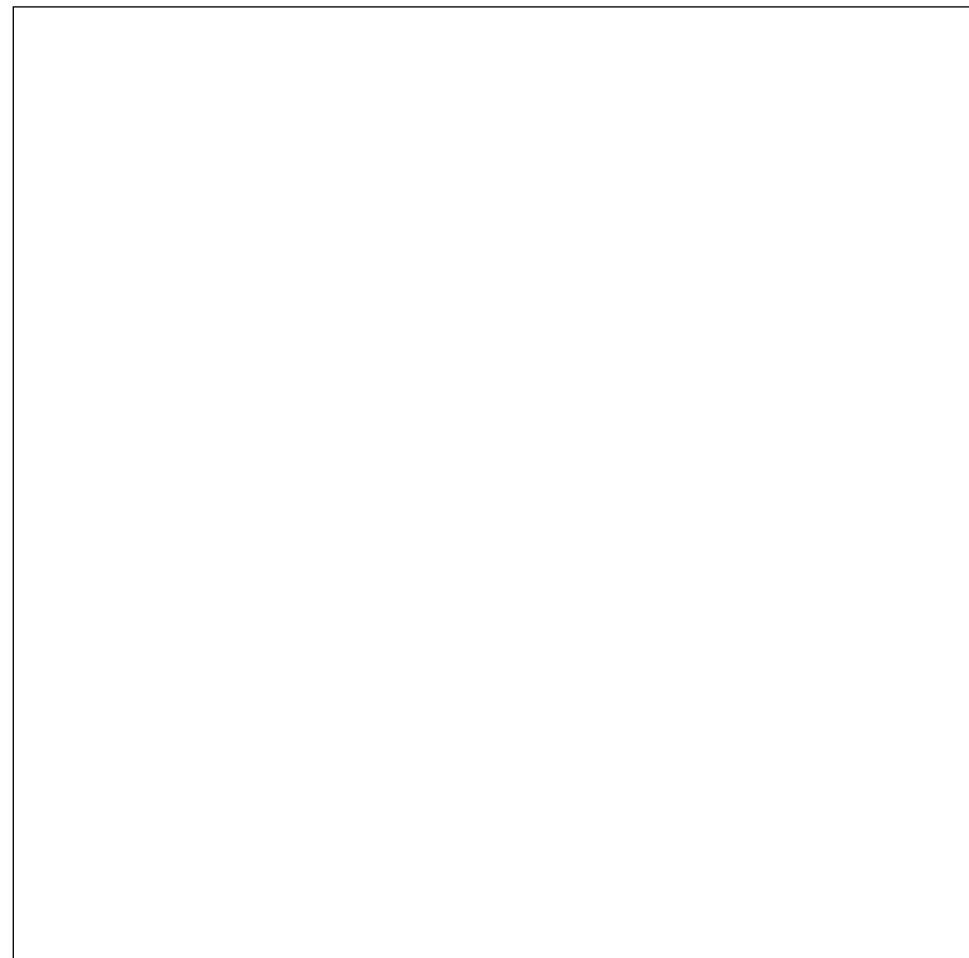
“Someone’s been eating my porridge,” said Baby Bear, “and it’s all gone!”



Then they looked at the chairs.

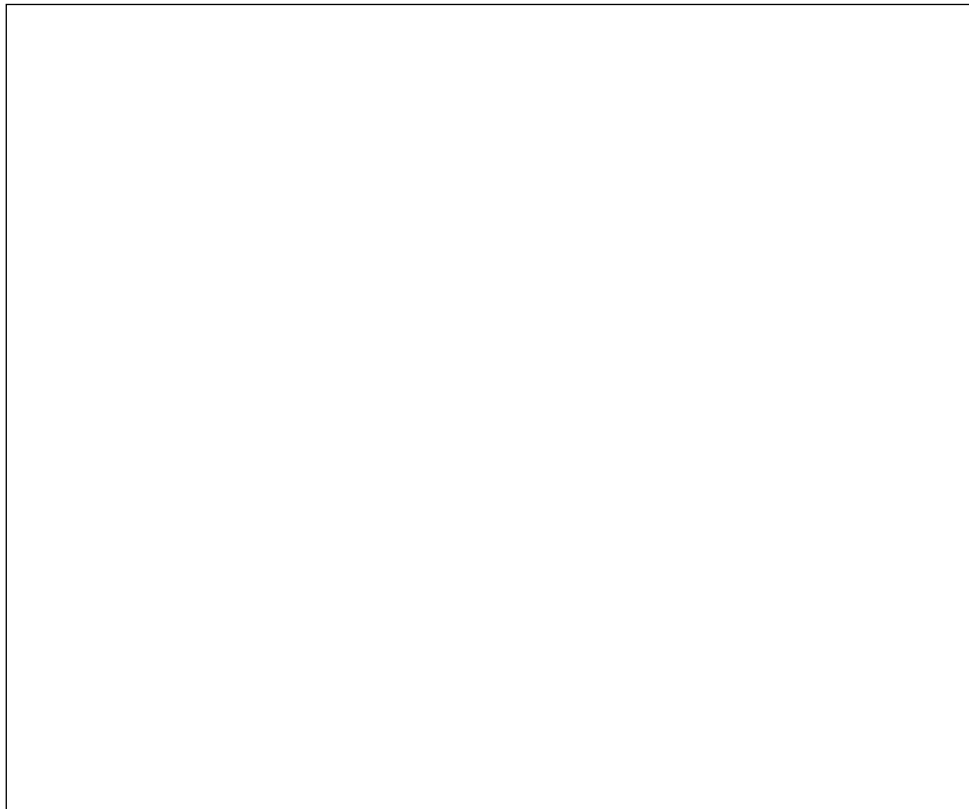
“Someone’s been sitting in my chair,” said Baby Bear, “and it’s broken!”

Deep in the forest was a cottage and in the cottage lived three bears. There was Daddy Bear, Mummy Bear and Baby Bear.



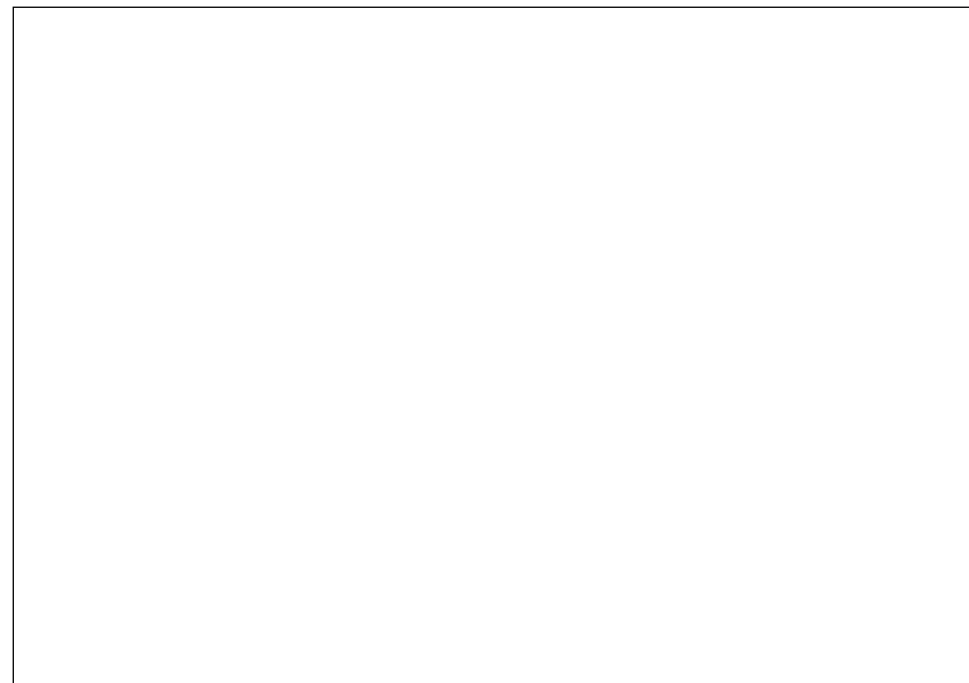
One morning Mummy Bear made some porridge. It was too hot to eat, so the three bears went out for a walk while it cooled down.
