

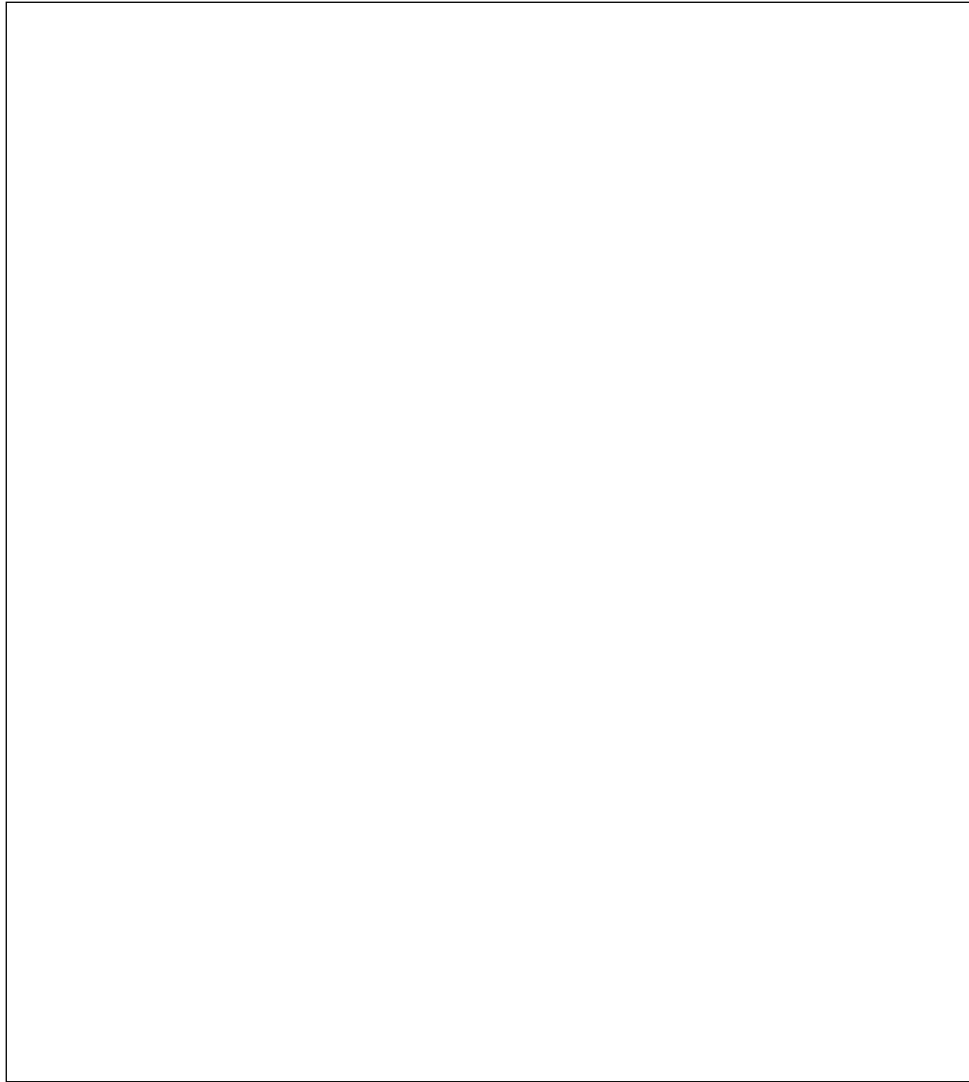

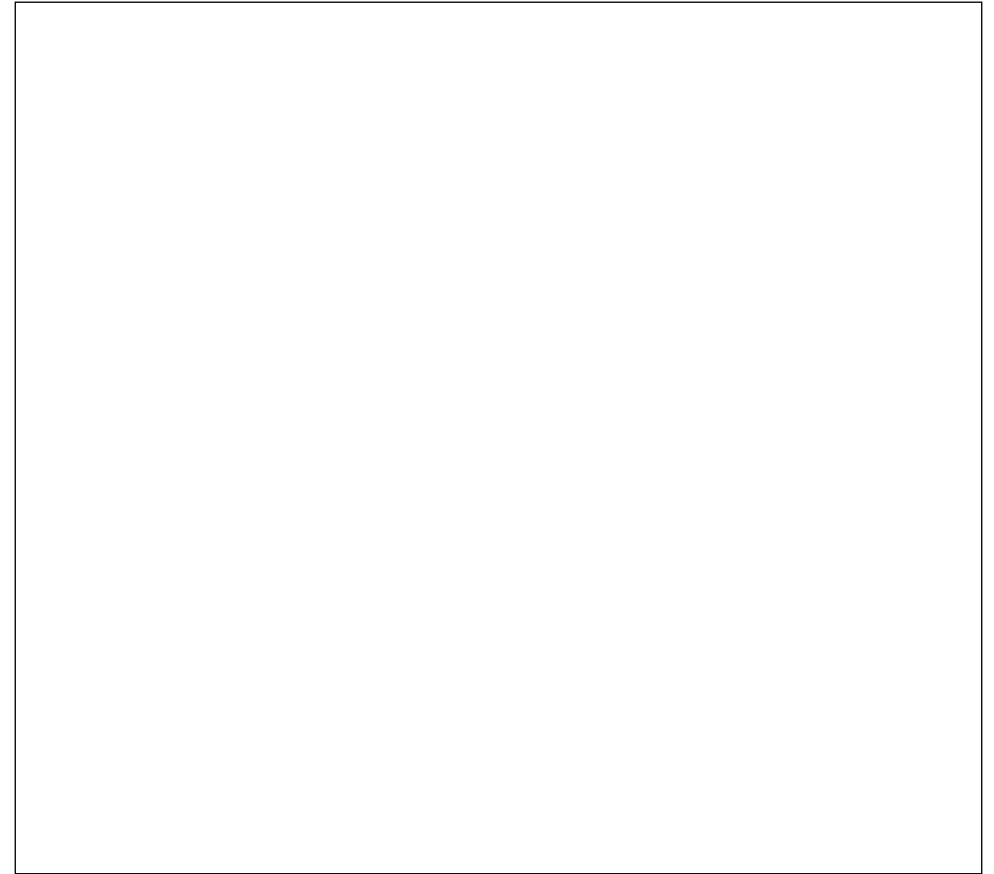

Once upon a time there was a widow who lived with her son, Jack. They were very poor and had to sell their cow to get money for food.

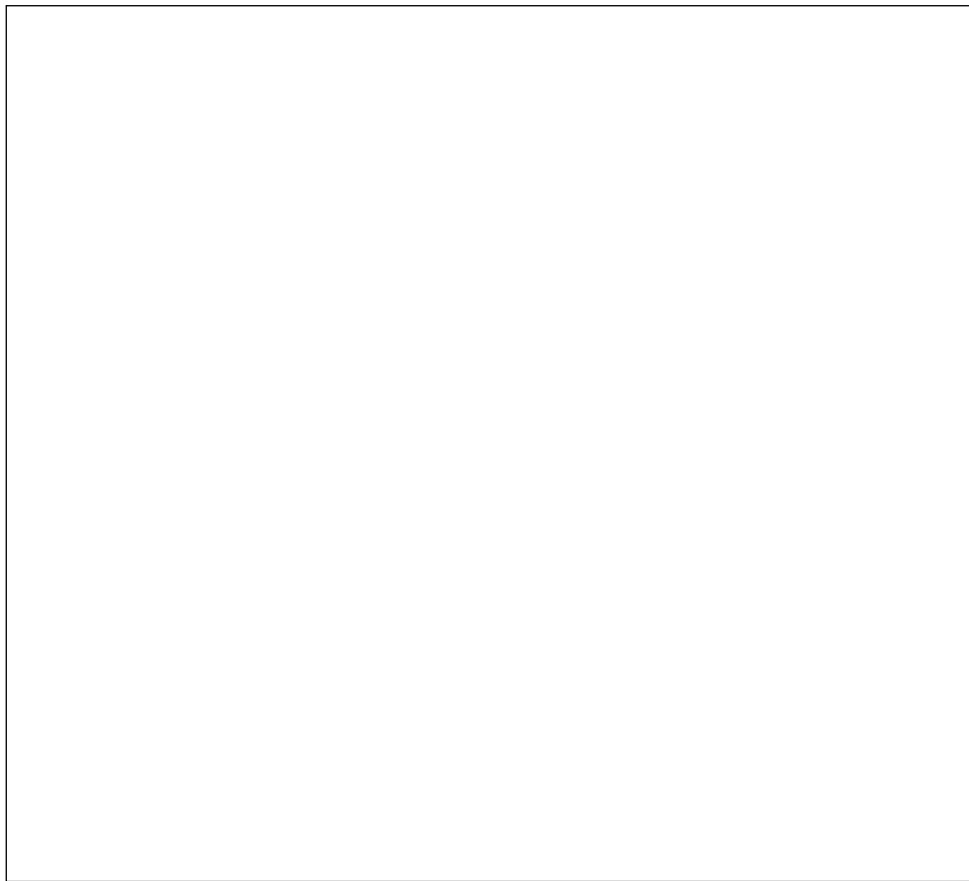
Jack jumped out of the cupboard and grabbed the hen and the harp. He ran out of the castle and down the beanstalk. The giant woke up and chased him.

Jack and his mother kept the hen and the harp and lived happily ever after.

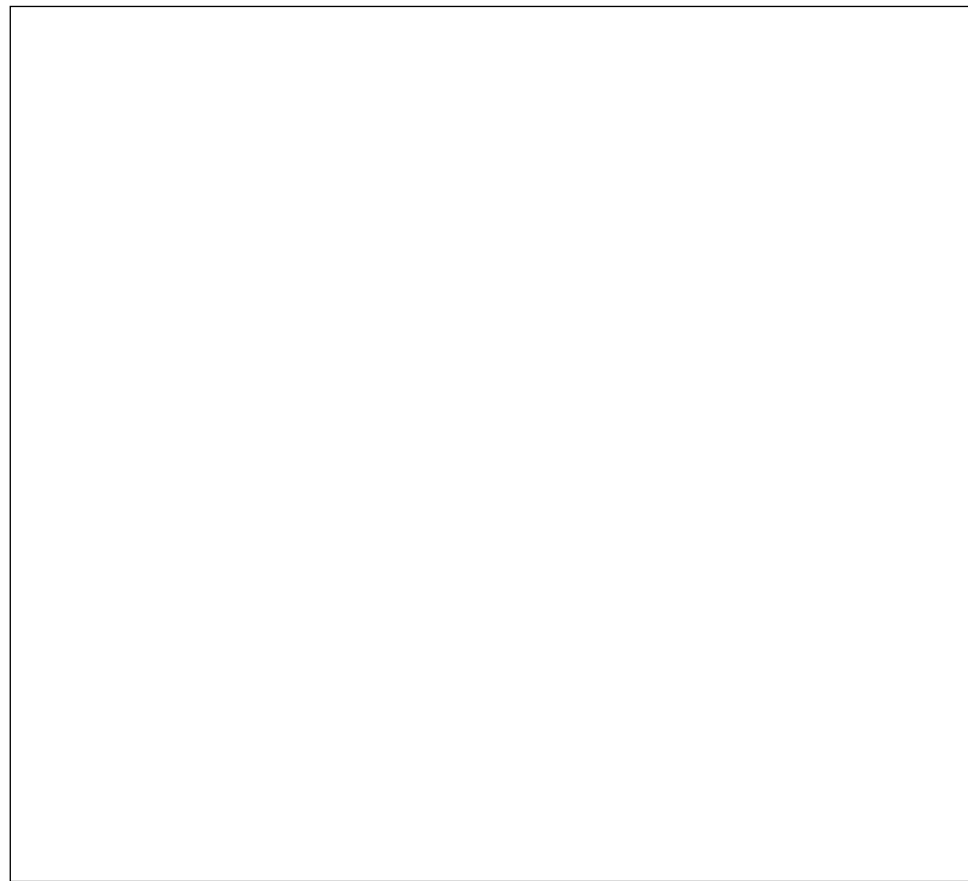
The giant ate an enormous dinner. Then he asked for his hen and his golden harp.



The hen laid a beautiful golden egg and the harp played a beautiful tune.

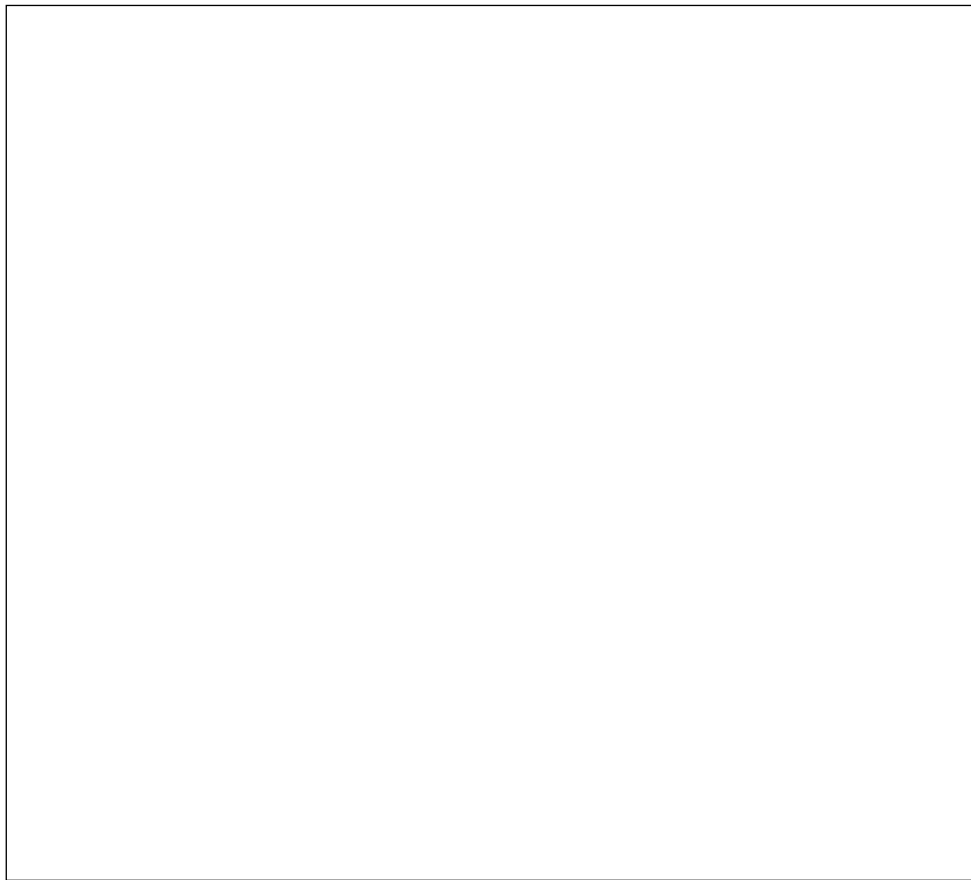
As the music played, the giant fell asleep.

“I’ll give you these magic beans for your cow,” said the man.



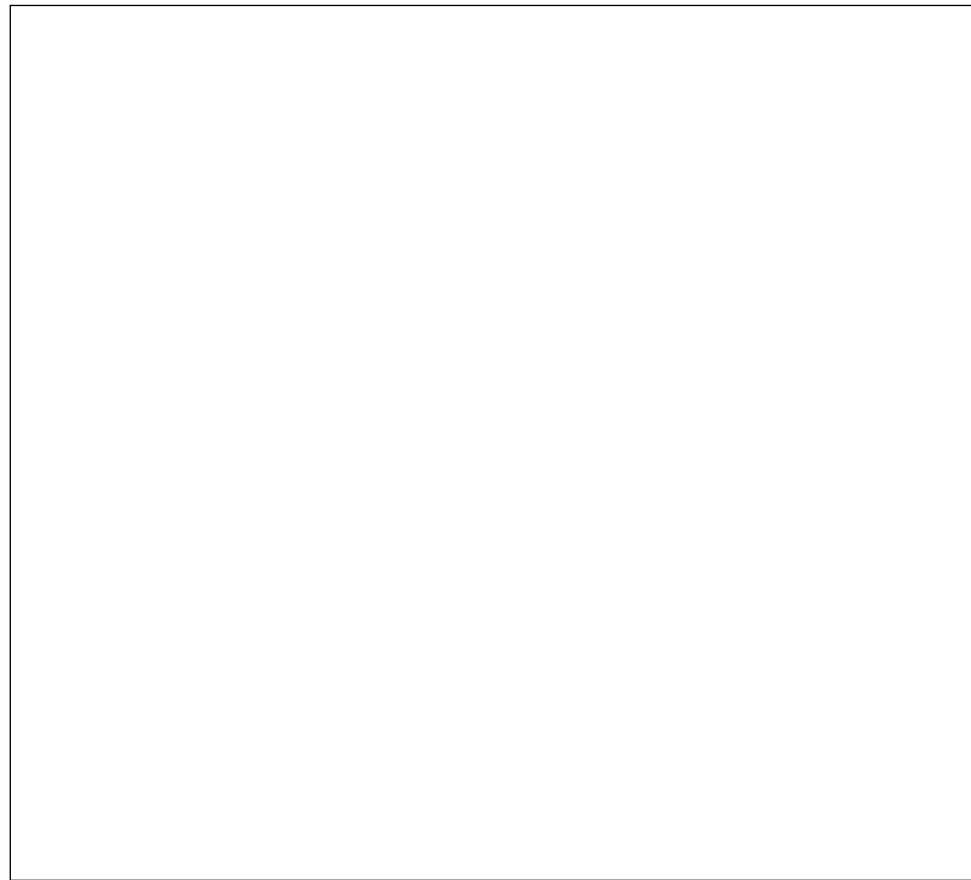
When Jack showed his mother the beans, she was so angry that she threw them out of the window. She sent Jack to bed.
