How To Make: A POPPY DISPLAY



You will need:

Red paper plates – many!

Black paper

Scissors

Blue tac – quite a bit of it!

Glue

Pencil or pen



STEP 1. First, before making your poppy, write a short poem about Remembrance Day. Think about why we have one day of the year set aside to pay our respects to those who have lost their lives at war. Write your poem on a piece of paper and set it aside. You'll come back to this later.



STEP 2. On a red paper plate, draw out a poppy shape using a pen or pencil. It could have two petals or four!

STEP 3. Cut out your poppy shape and put it on the side.



STEP 4. Cut out a black circle and stick it to the centre of your poppy.



STEP 5. Now, re-write your poem from earlier onto the petals of your poppy. Be sure to use your best handwriting.



STEP 6. Apply some blue tac to the back of your poppy and stick it to your display area.



STEP 7. Repeat this process multiple times until you have filled a space with poppies. This craft is easy enough for each child to make more than one poppy which could result in an enormous and breath-taking display!
